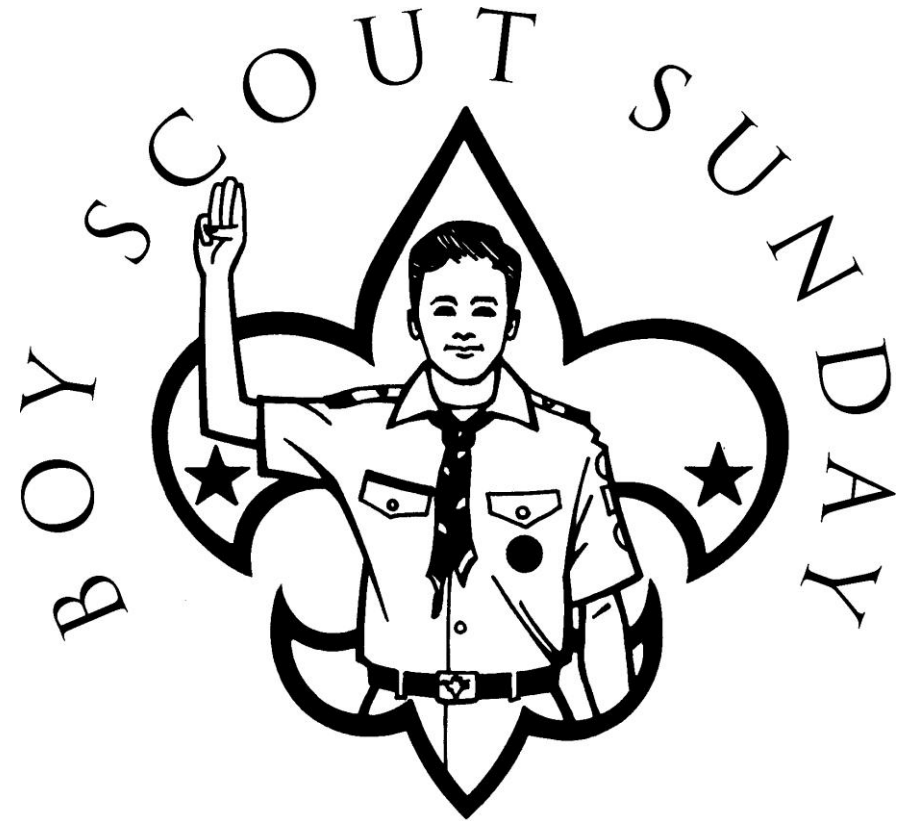
The altar flowers are given by Mary Steele, to the glory of God and in honor of Bill's birthday on February 14th, and in thanks to our caring congregation.
