Our **guest speaker today** is the Reverend Dr. Justin Allen of Shenandoah University. He is the Dean of Spiritual Life and Director of the Institute for Church Professions at the University.

A native Virginian, Dr. Allen completed his undergraduate degree with honors at Greensboro College and his Masters of Divinity with honors at Wesley Theological Seminary in Washington, D.C. His Doctor of Ministry Degree is also from Wesley Theological Seminary, in the area of Church Leadership. He is an ordained elder in the United Methodist Church and a member of the Virginia Conference.

Following pastoral assignments in Virginia and Tennessee, Allen was named director of the Wesley Foundation (a ministry to students, faculty and staff) at the University of Memphis. His five years leading campus ministry in Memphis was distinguished by "raising from the dead" a dormant ministry and bringing it to a robust life. Allen gained a reputation at the University of Memphis for effectively communicating the Christian faith while honoring and respecting persons of other faith perspectives.

Allen's wife Alethea is a pediatrician. They are the parents of daughter Camdyn, 7, and son Charlie, 4. Please give Rev. Allen and his family a warm Providence welcome today.
